What is past tense?

The past tense tell us what has already happened.

Look at the two sentences below; one is in the past tense and one in the present.

I am **skateboarding** down my road.

I **skateboarded** down my road.

Adding 'ed' to Make a Past Tense Verb

The difference between the present and past tense statements was the verb 'skateboarding'. In the past tense, an 'ed' was added to make the past tense verb.

Making a past tense verb is not always as simple as adding an 'ed' to the verb. Sometimes the past tense can change the spelling of the original (root) word too.

The 'ed' suffix can make 3 sounds, but...they all end with the same 'ed' ending.

/ed/	/d/	/t/
painted	played	looked
shouted	cleaned	liked




