1 Birch Catkins

Pollen producing ones are dangling down.
Pollen catching ones, that will develop into seeds, are standing up.

5 points

6 Rowan Blossom

Will turn into bright red berries by August.

7 points



2 Dog Violet

Just as pretty as sweet violets, but doesn't smell the same.

12 points

7 Willow Catkins

This one is a Goat Willow, with round leaves.

5 points



3 Herb Robert


Closely related to Crane's Bill.

8 Oak Catkins

Sometimes the biggest plants have the smallest flowers!

10 points



4 Cow Parsley


This is the plant that makes our forest school into a jungle. It is harmless, but it has very poisonous relatives!

These love woods, but hate being trodden on.

5 Cherry Blossom

17 Willow Catkins

This one is a white Willow, with long, thin leaves.

13 Hawthorne


or The May Tree

18 Mallow

A relative of the Marsh Mallow, whose roots used to be used to make marsh mallow sweets (but not any more).

14 Forget-me-not

Notice the bright yellow centres of the tiny flowers.

19 Deadnettle

Carefully rub the leaves, they don't sting.

15 Cuckoo Flower or Lady's Smock


A hard one to find!
