Can you give me an example?

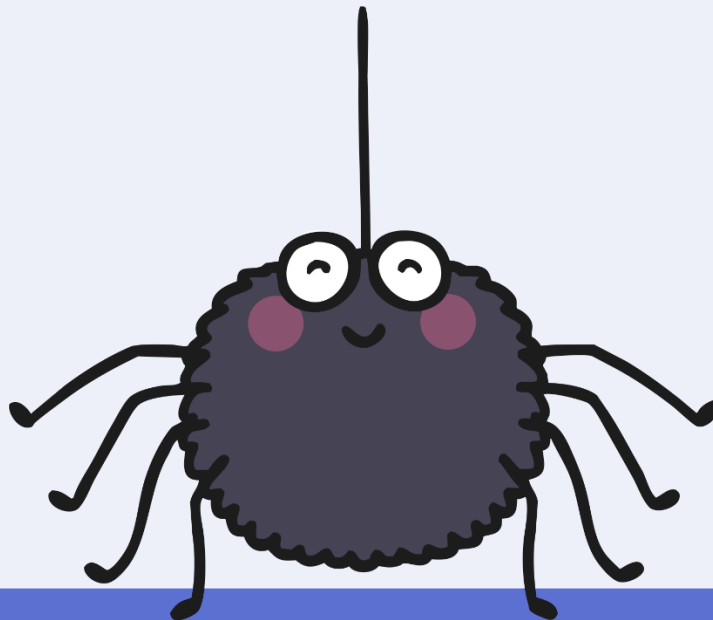
Today we are looking at adjectives.

How could we improve this description with adjectives?

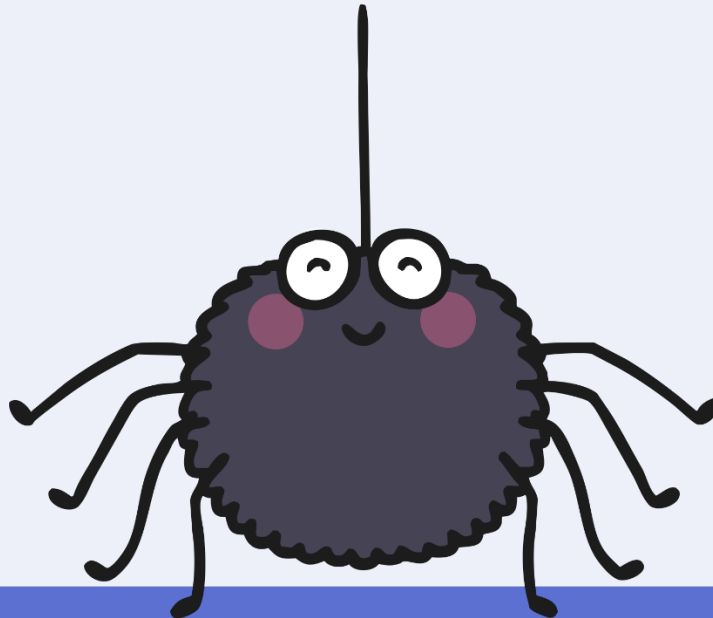

There was a spider in the bathroom.

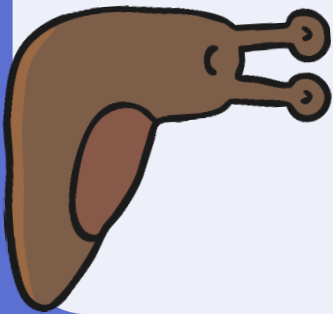
+ adjectives =

A slug was in my kitchen.

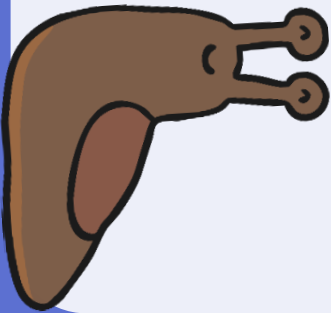
How can you improve this?



A slug was in my kitchen.

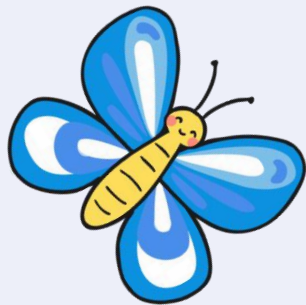
+ adjectives =

A butterfly flew into my house.

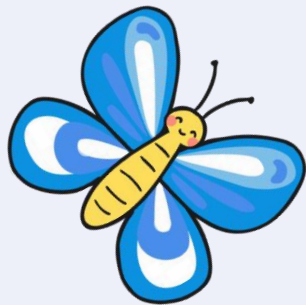
How could you describe the butterflies flying or the colour of the butterfly?

The **wiggly, pink** worm dug through the soil.

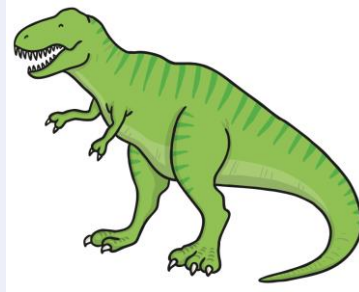

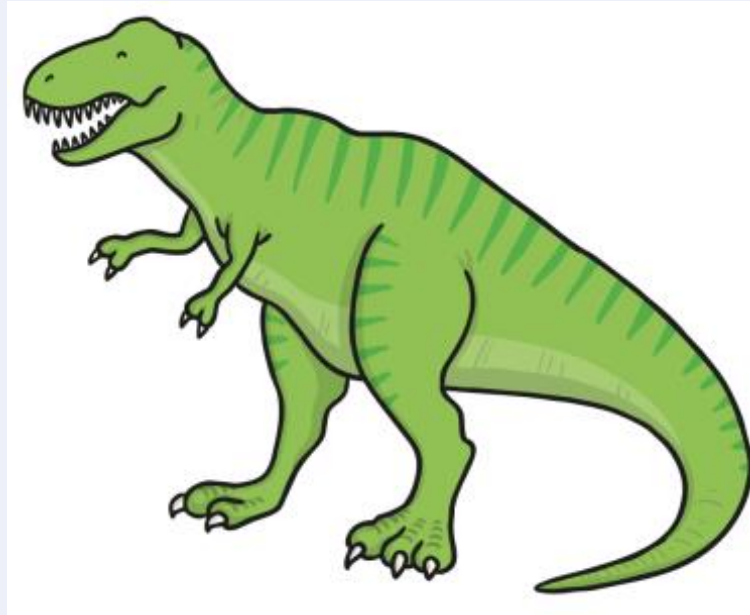
