## What is a noun?

A noun is a naming word.

cat

## What is a plural?



Plural means 'more than one'.

| Singular $=1$ | Plural = more than 1 |
| :---: | :---: |
| One table | Lots of tables |
| One candle | $\rightarrow$ Lots of candles |
| One pencil | Lots of pencils |
| One phone | $\rightarrow$ Lots of phones |

## Rule 1: Just add 's'

This is the most common and straight forward rule to make a word plural.

Rule 3: Words ending in ' $y$ ' change the ' $y$ ' to and ' $i$ ' before adding es.
e.g. baby $\longrightarrow$ babies


## Some more examples:

## teddy <br> teddies

welly $\Longrightarrow$ wellies
pony
ponies

## *exception*

If there is a vowel before the $y$, just add $s$.

## *Exceptions*

Watch out for words that do not fit that rule e.g. chief $\longmapsto$ chiefs

To help work out the exceptions to this rule listen for the change in sound when you say the word in its plural form.
*Roof = roofs
*Belief = beliefs
*Chef = chefs

* Handkerchief = handkerchiefs
