Where last?	 rich man unkind - Alemayu cheated - not allowed to look at a fire rich man plans great feast with friends servants cook food, but don't serve rich man hold instruments and move fingers, but no music
Feelings (main character)	 rich man cross: How can a smell fill a man's stomach same way looking at a fire can keep a small boy warm guests and servants laugh rich man angry BEHAVIOUR for FEELINGS? next day, Alemayu receives bag of money and four cows Alemayu became kind, rich man - servants happy working for him sister wise - people from all over Ethiopia visit her for advice
