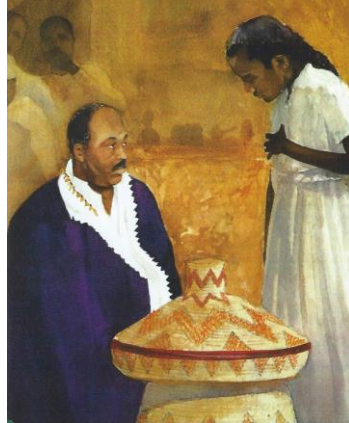

What goes wrong?		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • rich man boastful: once lost in mountains, leaned against mule and survived the cold • Alemayyu truthful: stayed in mountains overnight when looking after uncle's sheep

helps?



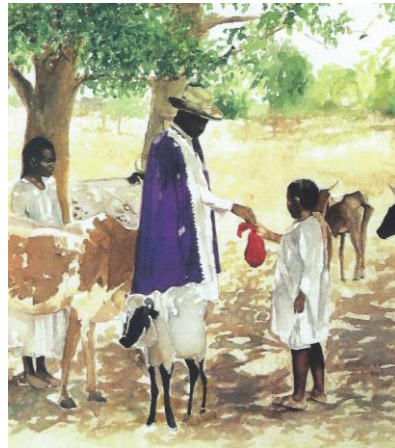
- cold, dark, hyenas howl, windy

last?



- rich man unkind - Alemayu cheated - not allowed to look at a fire
- rich man plans great feast with friends
- servants cook food, but don't serve rich man
- hold instruments and move fingers, but no music

- rich man cross: How can a smell fill a man's stomach
- same way looking at a fire can keep a small boy warm
- guests and servants laugh
- rich man angry
- BEHAVIOUR for FEELINGS?
- next day, Alemayu receives bag of money and four cows
- Alemayu became kind, rich man - servants happy working for him
- sister wise - people from all over Ethiopia visit her for advice
