

Making a booking

A group is defined as 15 or more paying visitors. Please call the reservations line seven days a week on 0121 393 6004. Fax messages may be sent to 0121 451 1366.

- Final numbers must be given two days before your visit by calling 0121 393 6004 or by emailing us
 on cwreservations@mdlz.com. You will be charged for the number of people quoted in your final
 numbers plus any additional visitors who arrive on the day
- Payment in full is due on arrival and we recommend that group leaders visit reception to make the payment before the group leaves the coach
- Groups larger than 60 people may be divided into smaller groups in order to accommodate them in the exhibition at timed intervals
- Groups who do not book in advance or who fall below 15 people will not be able to take advantage of our group benefits (discounts and free places) and will pay full price admission

Access facilities


- All areas of Cadbury World are accessible to wheelchair users. We recommend that group
 organisers notify the reservations team of the number of wheelchairs expected in the group,
 and seek advice on avoiding busy times
- Hearing loops are available at various points throughout the tour
- Assistance dogs only are allowed, except in the Chocolate Making zones, where a dog sitting service is available
- The 4D Cinema may not be suitable for adults or children who are easily startled by sudden movement, motion effects, loud music, or periods of darkness. It is not suitable for pregnant women or guests with heart conditions or spinal conditions due to motion effects used in the pre-show and 4D Cinema
- Audio guides are available in English, French, Spanish, Chinese, German and British Sign Language. A small charge may apply
- Accessible toilets, a Changing Places facility and baby changing rooms are available

Please note

- Cadbury World is located in the grounds of the original Cadbury factory, but isn't a tour of the factory itself
- It is possible to bring your group via public transport. The nearest train station to Cadbury World is 'Bournville' which is approximately a 15 minute walk away. Frequent buses run past the main entrance and information on bus routes is available from Traveline on traveline.info
- Children must be fully supervised at all times on the Cadbury World site
- We may need to close the African Adventure play area during wet weather
- Unfortunately, we are unable to store packed lunches brought into Cadbury World
- An average visit lasts about 3-4 hours including refreshments and shopping time
