Mummified Animals Found in Ancient Tomb

What have archaeologists discovered?

- Archaeologists have discovered a tomb which included around 50 mummified animals.
- The animals included cats, eagles, falcons, ibex (a type of wild goat) and mice.

Everyone knows about ancient Egyptian mummies. But now a tomb has revealed the range of animals this civilisation mummified.

Archaeologists found around 50 mummified animals, such as cats, mice and falcons. The discovery was made in a town called Sohag, 242 miles south of Egypt's capital city, Cairo.

They arrived just in the nick of time last October. A group of smugglers were digging for artefacts illegally. Fortunately, the thieves were caught in time so the experts could examine the remains of the tomb.

Experts say it's one of the best tombs to be discovered. It belonged to a man called Tutu and his wife, Ta-Shirit-Iziz. He was a nobleman, one of the wealthier people in ancient Egypt.

Their tomb is beautifully decorated with images of Tutu working on the land he owned and Ta-Shirit-Iziz playing a sistrum. This instrument is similar to a tambourine.

The dry, arid climate in which the tomb was found meant that the painted walls are in a near-perfect condition.

The range of animals has puzzled the team of archaeologists. It's well known that the ancient Egyptians mummified cats. They considered cats to be sacred. Bastet, an ancient Egyptian god, was a woman with a cat's head.

She protected the pharaohs in battle. Not only were they worshipped but cats were also pets.

It's thought that they were mummified so

that a pet and its owner would be reunited in the afterlife, where they would live with the gods.

However, such a large collection has not been heard of before.

The government in Egypt now hope more people will come to the country to see the finds.

smugglers	People who move items illegally into or out of a country.
sacred	Something that is thought to be close to a god.
afterlife	Where the ancient Egyptians thought people went after they died.
