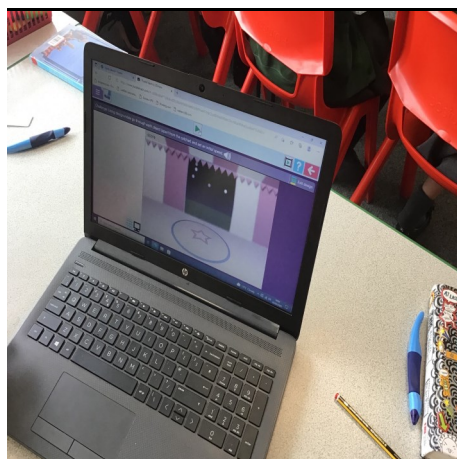
Highest class attendance for last week—**Class 6Y Mrs Khaira** and her pupils with a whopping **99.3%**

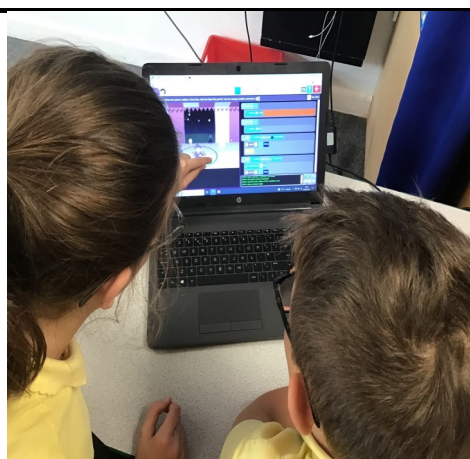
