Attendance News

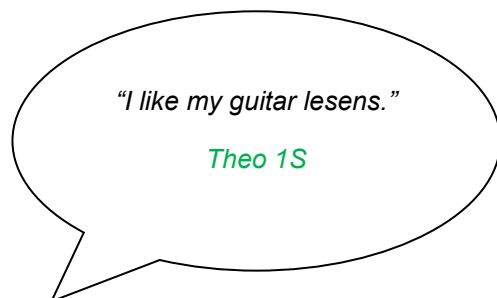


Highest class attendance for last week—Class **5G (Miss Goodrick)** and **RV (Ms Valentine)** both with **99.3%**

Focus on Excellence- March Maths Drop-in

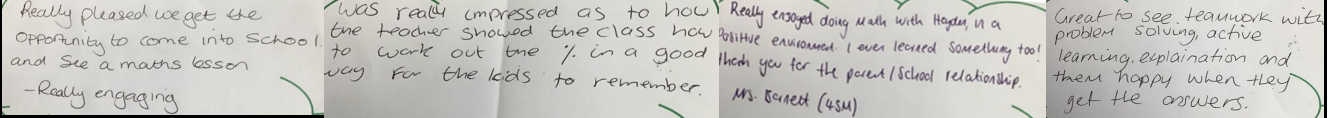
At Woodloes Primary School, we feel very passionate about each child receiving the best start to their Mathematical learning.
