<p>Where last? back to Hooligan Village</p>		<p><i>Behaviour to show Feelings / Prepositions on Fronted Adverbials / Power of 3 / Expanded Noun Phrase</i></p>
<p>Feelings? (main character)</p>		<p><i>3- of Feelings on Fronted Adverbial / Behaviour to show Feelings / Double-ly Ending</i></p>
